



#### Joint Interest Committee Update:

Regarding the COPAS RTC MFI-XX project, the next RTF MFI-XX draft will be a Voting Draft which the team plans to distribute during the last week of February. With the distribution of the draft, a roll-out presentation will be provided to assist the local Chairs in an overview of the significant changes between Draft and the Voting Draft. A Draft 3 Comments Summary including the comments received and the team's discussion and disposition of those comments will be provided at that time on the COPAS website.

Society Chairs will be asked to review and obtain a vote from committee members (those eligible for voting, not a straw poll) either at their March and/or April meeting. There will be two votes: One to approve the RTC MFI-XX Voting Draft and then if that is approved, the next vote will be to retire AG-28, *Remote Technology Centers*. Formal votes by Society will be taken at the Spring 2020 meeting in Washington, D.C. Approval thresholds by committee are: Audit (majority); Joint Interest (2/3).
