**Luncheon Speaker:
Brendan Griffin
“White Collar Crime in the Oil Patch”**

Brendan Griffin became a Special Agent with the FBI in June 2004 and was initially assigned to the Columbia Division, Charleston Resident Agency where he worked Complex Financial Crimes, Organized Crime, and Safe Streets Task Force matters. In 2007, Special Agent Griffin was transferred to the New York Field Office where he investigated Violent Gangs and Money Laundering matters. In 2009, SA Griffin was promoted to Supervisory Special Agent and transferred to FBI Headquarters, Asset Forfeiture and Money Laundering Unit. In 2011, SA Griffin was transferred to the Washington Field Office and investigated Foreign Corrupt Practices Act and Healthcare Fraud matters. In 2014, SA Griffin transferred to the El Paso Division, Midland Resident Agency and became the Supervisory Senior Resident Agent in January 2016.
